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20mph Speed Reduction Initiative Transport

The effect of 20 mph zones on socioeconomic differentials has been substantial, reducing the gap in the number of casualties between the most and least deprived quintiles of deprivation by approximately 14% compared with what it would otherwise have been.¹ ²Some studies mix results from zones with limits in their results which, arguably, risks confusion as they are significantly different as interventions.

Road Safety factsheet: 20mph Zones and Speed Limits History of 20mph Speed Limits in the UK In December 1990 the Department of Transport issued Circular Roads 4/90 which set out guidelines for the introduction of 20mph speed limits; local authorities had to apply for consent from the Secretary of State to introduce a 20mph zone.

January 2020 20mph Zones and Speed Limits Factsheet

The Department for Transport advise traffic authorities to keep their speed limits under review with changing circumstances, and to consider the introduction of more 20 mph limits and zones, over time, in urban areas and built-up village streets that are primarily residential, to ensure greater safety for pedestrians and cyclists.

In fact the ave speed reduction per mile of road per £1,000 cost is about 7 times greater with a 20mph default compared to physical calming. Site specific 20mph limits with physical calming not only limit the reduction to a tiny proportion of roads but also endorse higher speeds on the rest of the network.

Report recommends default 20mph limit in Wales

On the types of urban road likely to be considered for a 20 mph speed limit the study found the accidents could be expected to fall by between 4% and 6% for each 1 mph reduction in average speed. The greatest reductions were achievable on "busy main roads in towns with high levels of pedestrian activity"¹¹ ²¹.
