A Canadian passport is the only reliable and universally accepted travel and identification document available to Canadians for the purpose of international travel. Canadian citizens returning to Canada who present other documents instead of a Canadian passport may face delays or be denied boarding by transport companies.

#### Certificate of Canadian Citizenship - Travel.gc.ca

If you were born in Canada, the birth certificate issued by the province or territory where you were born is your proof of Canadian citizenship. Birth certificates issued by the Government of Quebec before January 1, 1994, are no longer accepted when you apply for a citizenship certificate.

#### What documents should I send with my application for a ...

Canadian Citizenship Application Checklist includes form CIT 0002, Document Checklist (CIT 0007), Citizenship Photo Specifications, Form CIT 0177, and FormIMM 5476. The form is intended for the candidates who want to apply for Canadian Citizenship. Applicants using CIT 0007 form must be Canadian Permanent Resident, be aged 18 or older.

Form CIT 0001E is used by Canadian Citizens, who reside in or outside of Canada when they need to prove their Citizenship. Any Canadian Citizen over the age of 18 may apply for a citizenship certificate. A parent may also apply on behalf of a minor under the age of 18.

If you are applying for your first citizenship certificate, provide clear and legible, certified copies, of your documents. If it is for a replacement, provide clear and legible photocopies of your documents. Note.

We accept the following documents to show your status in Canada: Canadian birth certificate. Canadian citizenship certificate or card. Canadian passport. Confirmation of permanent residence (IMM 5292 or IMM 5688) Permanent resident card. Record of landing (IMM 1000) Secure certificate of Indian status. Canadian birth certificate.

#### Where is my status in Canada document number?

The Canadian citizenship certificate (formerly citizenship card) is a document used by naturalized Canadian citizens to prove their status in Canada. If you have become a Canadian citizen after immigrating to Canada, you have to show your original citizenship document when you Renew your Canadian passport Renew your health card

Canadian citizenship is typically obtained either on the principle of jus soli, i.e. by birth in Canada; or under the rules of jus sanguinis, i.e. by birth abroad to at least one parent with Canadian citizenship or by adoption by at least one Canadian citizen.
