Corrective and Preventive Actions (CAPA) | FDA

Corrective and preventive action (CAPA or simply corrective action) consists of improvements to an organization's processes taken to eliminate causes of non-conformities or other undesirable situations. It is usually a set of actions that laws or regulations require an organization to take in manufacturing, documentation, procedures, or systems to rectify and eliminate recurring non-conformance.

A preventive action plan, created for preventive actions, needs to include all of the same things that a corrective action plan does, as outlined above. If you are taking action to remove an identified risk, this should also be treated like a project, with the same adequate oversight and budgeting of resources.

Difference Between Corrective Action and Preventive Action ...

Corrective Action is a reactive measure as it focuses on what has happened, whereas preventive action is a proactive measure as it lays emphasis on what might happen. The corrective action takes place when the defect is detected. In contrast, preventive action takes place before detecting the defect.

ISO 9001 requires the organization to have a documented procedure for corrective and preventive action. Note: The combination of corrective action and preventive action documented procedures into a single QMS document is acceptable, but is not recommended.
