The present drought risk reduction framework proposes the following main elements for consideration, namely: i) drought policies and governance, ii) drought risk identification, impact assessment, and early warning, iii) drought awareness and knowledge management, and iv) effective drought mitigation and preparedness measures.

### Drought Risk Reduction Framework and Practices

Such an approach often referred to as a drought risk management/climate risk management (DRM/CRM), is essential in ensuring that the development process is free from the risks of short-term climate variability and long-term change. DRM applies the risk formula ( $RISK = HAZARD \times VULNERABILITY / RESILIENCE$ ) in drought management.

### Mainstreaming Drought Risk Management

Fragmented responsibilities for drought risk management In Viet Nam, responsibility for drought risk is centralized within the national government, but the management of drought risk drivers falls between different institutions responsible for managing forests, agriculture, water and land use. (Shaw et al., 2010)

### Towards Developing National Drought Management Policy: The ...

Drought Policy The final goal of the project aims at integrating the first two axes (Groundwater drought indicators & Drought vulnerability) in a process of policy making on drought management. This requires a dialogue with the different national actors involved.

### Drought Policy

The policy aims to shift responsibility for managing drought risk from government to the farmer, with financial assistance and food security interventions only being considered in the event of an extreme or 'disaster' drought being declared.

The risk for drought is a combined effect of drought hazard (likelihood) and drought consequence (vulnerability). Drought hazard is defined by the frequency of occurrence of drought at various levels of intensity and duration, and this data is crucial for drought risk management for assessing the impacts.
