Collins's work concluded with three central claims: Oppressions of race, class, gender, sexuality and nation are intersecting, mutually constructing systems of power. Collins utilizes the term "intersectionality," coined by Kimberlé Crenshaw, to refer to this simultaneous overlapping of multiple forms of oppression.

Sociologist Patricia Hill Collins developed and explained the concept of intersectionality in her groundbreaking book, *Black Feminist Thought: Knowledge, Consciousness, and the Politics of Empowerment*, published in 1990.

Intersectionality - Definition and Discussion

The three dimensions of oppression that are discussed by Patricia Hill Collins are individual, institutional and symbolic. The individual is being capable of being oppressed and of oppressing others. An example of individual oppression is when a White Bank employer does not hire an African American because of his race.
